Pre-construction and construction services are being provided for the expansion and renovation of the historic Cleveland Museum of Art at University Circle, the cultural hub of Cleveland. Plans call for more galleries, more underground parking and a glass-covered courtyard which will be the centerpiece of the project that will be built between the museum's 1916 building and 1971 addition designed by Marcel Breuer. The north facade's marble of the 1916 building will be restored to its original beauty. Gallery space will be increased from 94,000 square feet to 131,000 square feet. Overall, the museum will grow from its current floor space of 389,000 square feet to 559,000 square feet and parking spaces will also be increased from its 500 car capacity to 825.
